Concerns and Questions:

- Concerns about older kids on school property during school hours. Kids were reminded to leave property and they did.
- Kids on skateboards coming down the hill on 400 North during the morning commute to school. Teachers remind kids to ride on the sidewalk and not on the street
- Council suggested a safety assembly. Kali stated she discussed safety rules with kids at the beginning of the year and Darla is looking into a safety program for possible assembly, e.g., [\*\*SNAP Walk and Roll Assembly\*\*](#)
- Lots of parents are walking kids to school and express the possibility of cutting curbs down so bikes, skateboards and strollers can have an easier access. Kali reported that the district is already planning on fixing the problem.
- Jena asked if next meeting we could have data to show if we made our 1% growth in reading and math. Kali responded this information was going to be discussed at Grade level data dive. Kali will bring the results to the October meeting to discuss if our goal was met.
